Founded in 2018 by the violinist Maria Tió, cellist Ferran Bardolet, and pianist Ricard Rovirosa, the Tempus Trio has been recognized by both critics and audiences as one of the most promising ensembles of their generation. They have achieved significant success in various international music competitions, including the first prize at the 2019 "**Grand Prize Virtuoso**" **International Music Competition in Brussels**, the Platinum Medal (First Prize) at the 2019 "**WPTA Singapore International Music Competition**", the Silver Medal at the "**2nd Vienna International Competition 2020**" and a special prize at the "**BBVA Montserrat Alavedra International Competition 2021**".

During the past season, they were selected to be "Artistas en ruta," the resident ensemble of the "Asociación de Intérpretes de España" (AiE). Since January 2022, they have been the resident group for the concert series at the Mirabell Palace in Salzburg.

Currently, the Tempus Trio is pursuing a Master's in Chamber Music at the prestigious **Mozarteum University in Salzburg** under the guidance of Professor Cibrán Sierra Vázquez, who is a violinist in the Quiroga Quartet.

Maria, Ferran, and Ricard are three musicians who have individually received their training at the finest music institutions under the tutelage of esteemed professors such as Joan Havill (Guildhall School of Music and Drama), Esther Hoppe (Universität Mozarteum), and Natalia Shakhovskaya (Escuela Superior de Música Reina Sofía). Their individual careers have also been marked by numerous awards in national and international competitions, and they have accumulated extensive concert experience, having performed in prominent concert halls across Europe, Asia, and America, earning the applause of both audiences and critics, as well as the attention of major audiovisual media.
