TRIO CONCEPT

Trio Concept was founded in 2013 by three young musicians from Turin: **Edoardo Grieco** (violin), **Francesco Massimino** (cello), and **Lorenzo Nguyen** (piano).

Recently named **ECHO Rising Star for the 2025/2026** season, the Trio was awarded the Prix Yves Paternot – the highest distinction of the Verbier Festival – following a three-week residency at the 2024 Academy, in recognition of its “outstanding talent and artistic excellence.”

In June 2023, after a three-stage selection process and a final performance at Wigmore Hall in London, the Trio was appointed a YCAT Artist. That same year, it won First Prize at the Schoenfeld International Competition in Harbin (China) and was selected as an ensemble in residence by ProQuartet in Paris.

In Italy, Trio Concept was awarded Second Prize (with First not assigned) and three special prizes at the Premio Trio di Trieste, becoming the youngest ensemble ever recognized in the competition’s history. It also received the Giovanna Maniezzo Prize from the Accademia Chigiana and was named “Ensemble of the Year 2020/2021” by Le Dimore del Quartetto. The Trio has been supported by De Sono Associazione per la Musica.

Edoardo Grieco plays a 1766 Pietro Antonio Landolfi violin, generously loaned by Irene Miller and the Beares International Violin Society, and Francesco Massimino performs on the “Oro del Reno” cello, built by Gaetano Sgarabotto in Milan in 1948.
